Dear Dr. Jones:

Thank you for your letter of June 24, 2013, providing notification that all courses now being taught through a cooperative agreement with Texas A&M University-Texarkana are taught exclusively online.

Through a joint cooperative agreement approved by the Commission in a letter, dated September 14, 2009, the University offered the Doctor of Education degree in Educational Administration at Texas A&M University-Texarkana (7101 University Avenue, Texarkana, TX 75503). Courses were offered at Texarkana through interactive video and via the internet.

All coursework taught by Texas A&M University-Commerce to Texas A&M University-Texarkana students is now being taught entirely online. No face-to-face or interactive, televised courses will be taught on-site in Texarkana by Texas A&M University-Commerce. Thus Texas A&M University-Commerce no longer teaches courses on site in Texarkana.

We approve the discontinuation of the offering of courses on site at Texas A&M University-Texarkana and acknowledge the offering of courses to Texarkana students entirely online.
