We are already over a third of the way into the semester and as we make our way through October, I'm sure many are enjoying the cooler weather. I just have a few short, but important, updates for you:

- I'm happy to share that the Refreshed Strategic Plan can be found in both English and Spanish on our website at https://www.tamuc.edu/strategic-plan/. Thank you to all the committees that worked on this. Discussions are currently underway with the Executive Team on the next steps for the university, with general instruction for each division. As I know more, I will be working with the Deans Council, as well as the Faculty Senate and the Department Head Council, to identify the next steps for the Division of Academic Affairs. As always, if this is an area of high interest for you, please feel free to reach out directly to your dean, department head, and/or the Senate. We are always looking for those who would like to join working committees.
- As many of you know, the Student Success Center opened its doors this semester, serving as a centralized location for students to receive guidance in areas such as advising, financial literacy, and career planning. I'm happy to share that the website for these services is now live at https://www.tamuc.edu/student-success-center/. Also, attached to this email is a flyer outlining the services or areas in the Student Success Center. I encourage you all to share with your students.
- After considerable exploration, the Deans Council has decided that we will be using D2L as a digitized process for tenure and promotion review, starting in Fall 2025. Details are currently being worked out, but the plan is to provide access for tenure-track faculty members early in their careers so they have the support needed for the tenure and promotion process. More information will be forthcoming. Thanks to CHSSA and HHP in COEHS for serving as the pilot programs! I am sure many will appreciate this process as we become more efficient in using time, reducing paper waste, and improving accessibility.

- We are excited to launch the *Investing in You: Junior Faculty Career Development and Support Initiative*, centered around three core competencies: enhancing performance, optimizing talent, and fostering collaborative relationships. Aligned with Texas A&M University-Commerce's mission of developing and supporting faculty, this initiative aims to advance the careers of junior faculty by focusing on the following key objectives:
 - Support the career development of junior faculty members
 - Enhance junior faculty retention by deepening their understanding of teaching, research, and service
 - Build future TAMUC academic leadership capacity by facilitating collaboration and networking

The inaugural *Investing in You* event, *Networking at Noon: Navigating Grants*, will take place on November 19, 2024, in BA 343 from 12:00 to 1:15 PM.
