The university promotes the development of its faculty through the implementation of a faculty development leave program. The program is designed to assist faculty members to develop and pursue worthy academic study, research, writing, field observation or other suitable purposes that require significant time and the absence of distractions. Faculty members (a) whose full-time duties are specified as primarily teaching and/or research (not administrative), and (b) have served as members of the A&M-Commerce faculty for a minimum of two consecutive, full-time academic years, are eligible to be considered for faculty development leave.
