The Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships administers and coordinates student financial aid and scholarship resources, and processes the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). These applications are available online at <https://studentaid.gov/> (FAFSA) and <http://www.collegeforalltexans.com/> (TASFA). The FAFSA is completed electronically by the student and submitted to the institution. The TASFA is either completed electronically through the state website or students can submit the paper form in person or by mail to the institution.

Students must complete the FAFSA or TASFA to establish eligibility for federal and state financial aid. The Financial Aid and Scholarships website provides a list of federal and state grants, loans, work-study, and scholarships for eligible students. The office also handles outside scholarships, department, and endowment scholarships awarded to recipients, and releases to Student Accounts.

Every semester the office monitors the eligibility of each financial aid and scholarship recipient to determine if he or she can continue to receive the assistance provided. Faculty members can direct their advisees to the financial aid and scholarships website for answers to many of their questions.

The Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships does not process tuition waivers, exemptions, VA benefits, third-party billings, prepaid tuition programs, or AmeriCorps. These programs are handled through Student Accounts.
