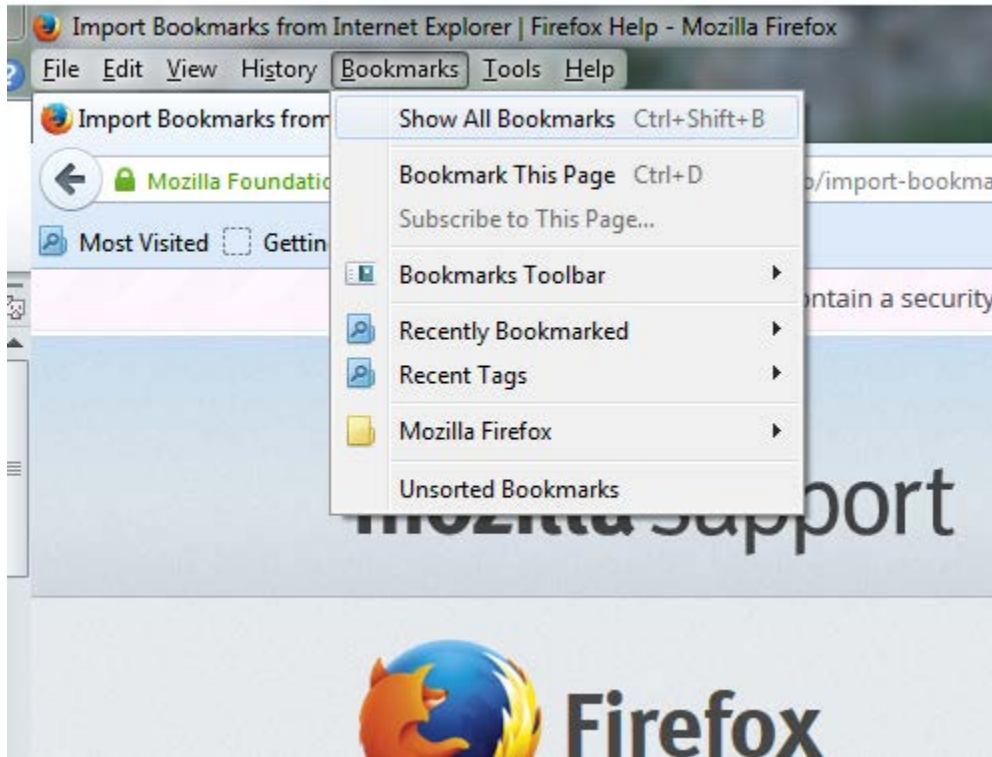
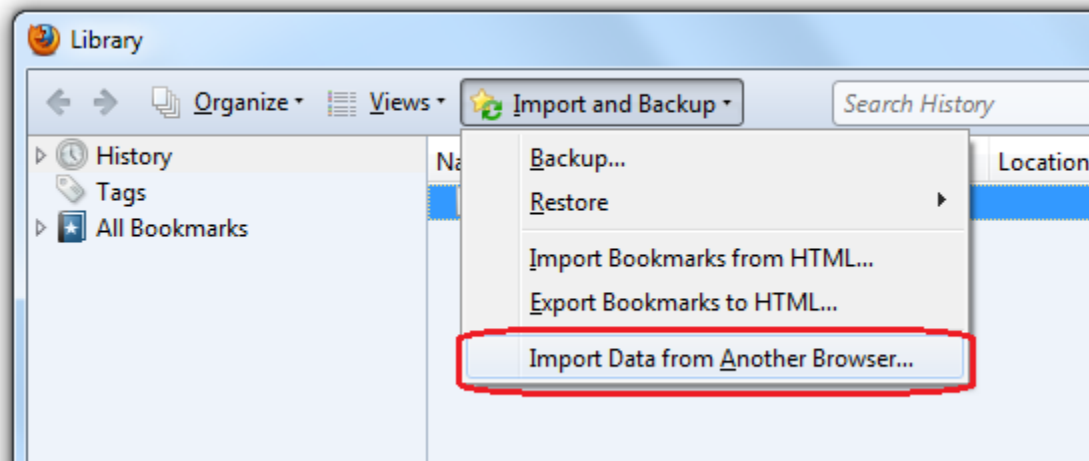


## Importing Bookmarks and Settings from Internet Explorer to Firefox

1. Click the Bookmarks button on the top-left of the window and select Show All Bookmarks to open the Library window.

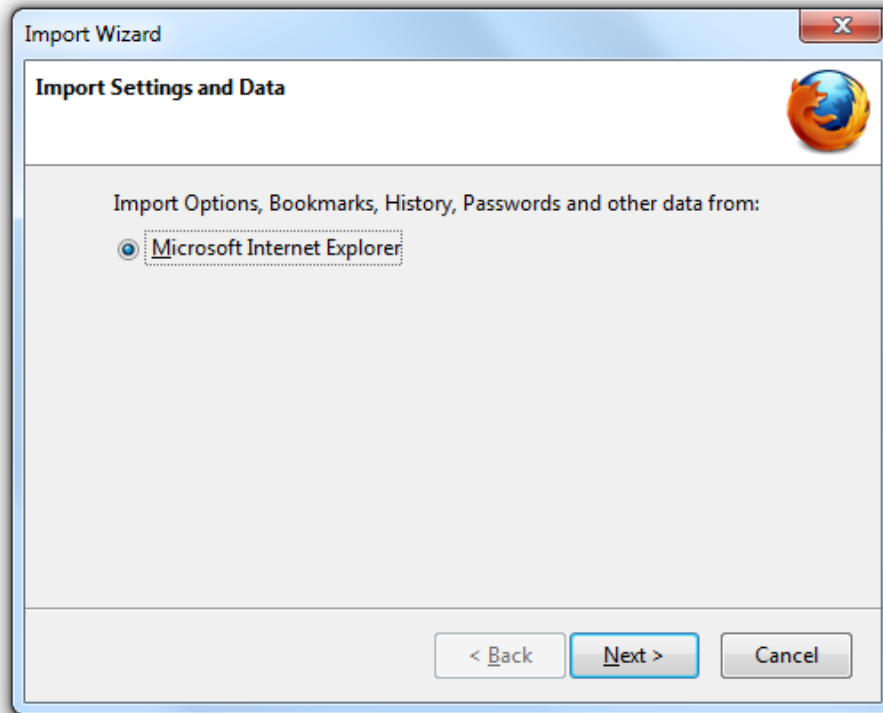


2. In the Library window, click Import and Backup and choose Import Data from Another Browser....

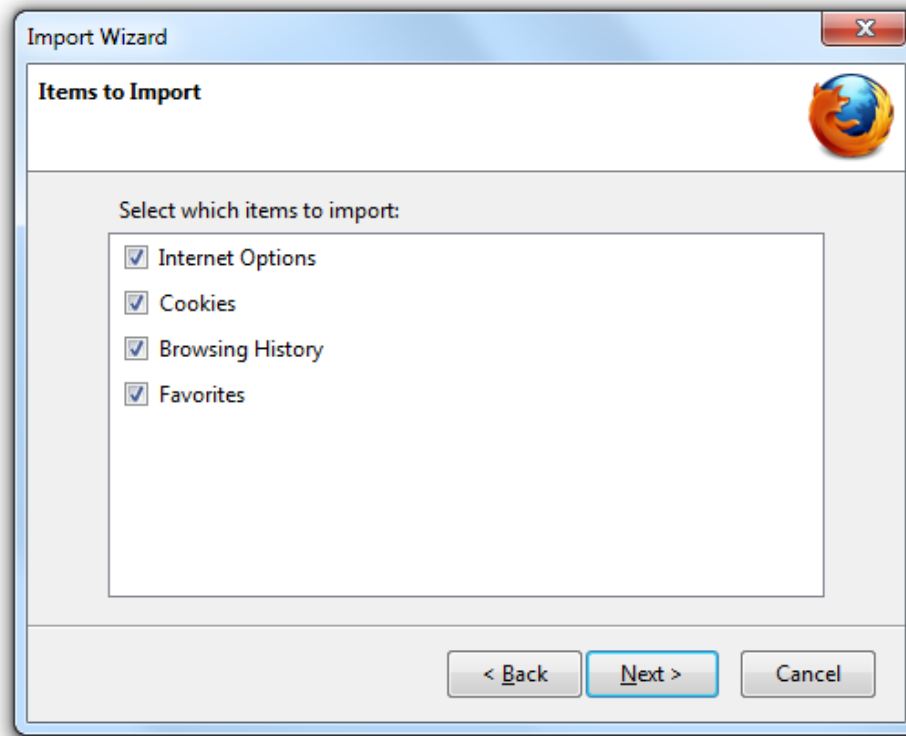


**Note:** If Import Data from Another Browser... is disabled (greyed out), this can happen if you are in [Private Browsing](#) mode. Close the Private Browsing window and try again.

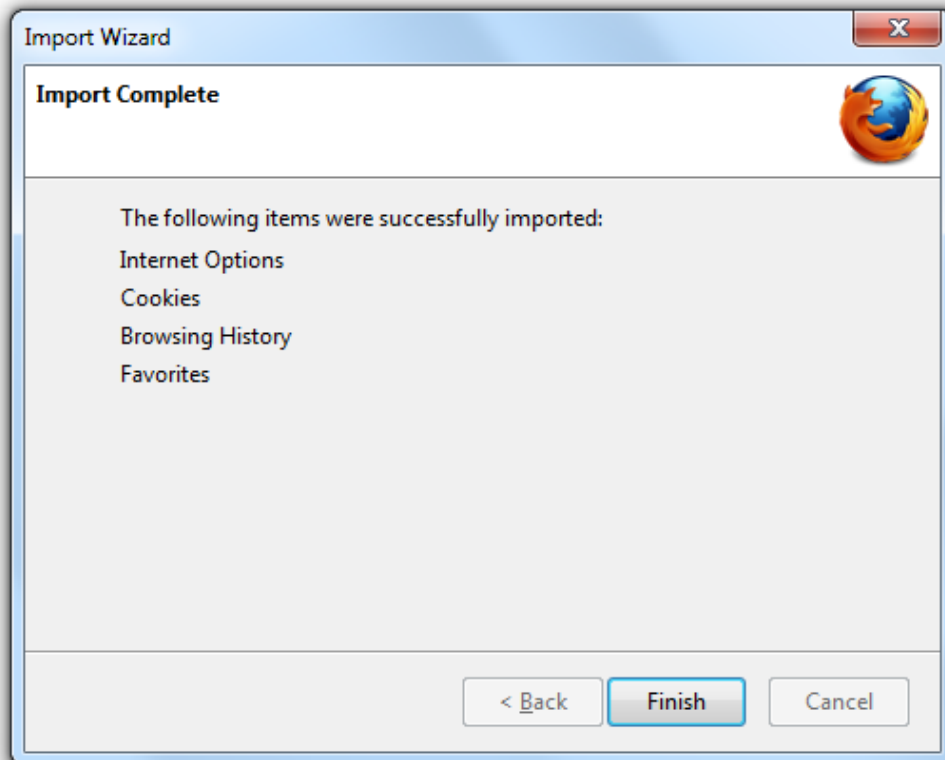
3. In the Import Wizard window that appears, select **Microsoft Internet Explorer**, then click Next.



4. Firefox will list the types of settings and information it can import. Select the items you want to import, then click Next.



- **Internet Options:** General settings, including your home page. Since Firefox and Internet Explorer have different features, Firefox won't be able to import all of your settings.
  - **Cookies:** Small bits of information stored on your computer by some websites that are used to keep you logged in, store your options, or do other things.
  - **Browsing History:** Information on the sites you have visited.
  - **Favorites:** Web pages you have saved in your Internet Explorer favorites.
5. Click Finish. The items you selected should now be imported.
