

# Sidebars - Quick Link

Quick Link Sidebars are lists of links to any internal asset page, external link asset, or pdf file. There are separate boxes for entering each type of asset.



## To create a Quick Links Sidebar:

- Create the asset (Note: If you miss one, you can always add it later).
- In the sidebar, browse to and select your \_sidebars folder so the sidebar you create will be stored there.
- In the menu bar, select **New > Sidebar Items > Quick Links**. The following dialog box will open.
