Procedure Statement

This procedure establishes the method used for formulating the Information Technology Strategic Plan on a biennial basis.

Reason for Procedure

The Texas Government Code requires institutions of higher education to prepare a strategic plan for its operations.

Procedures and Responsibilities

1. TIMING OF STRATEGIC PLANS

Each even-numbered year, the university shall issue a plan covering five fiscal years beginning with the next odd-numbered fiscal year.

2. COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEE

A committee headed by the Chief Information Officer will engage in a series of meetings to produce a new Information Resources Strategic Plan. The committee will consist of the people holding these positions:

- Director of Faculty Center for Teaching with Technologies
- Director of Financial Aid & Scholarships
- Director of Libraries
- University Registrar
- Director of Admissions-Undergraduate
- Executive Director of Budgets & Business Services

3. REQUIREMENTS OF STRATEGIC PLAN.

3.1. The plan produced must support the University Strategic Plan and the State Strategic Plan for Information Resources Management.

- 3.2. The Chief Information Officer will present the plan to the Vice President for Business and Administration.
- 3.3. The Vice President for Business and Administration will present the plan to the President's Advisory Council for approval.
