- Students will be able to <u>apply knowledge</u> of the interconnectedness of global dynamics.

# **GLOBAL FELLOWS PROGRAM**

### Award based on involvement and engagement with students

- Global Course Development and Instruction
- Global Events (planning, sponsoring, organizing, attending)
- Global Travel (planning, sponsoring, organizing, attending)
- Global Research
- Personal and Professional Development

#### **Benefits:**

- Certificate of status
- Medallion
- Recognition at convocations, banquets, campus events
- Selection of Global Scholar applicants
- Internal support funding
  - Requires direct involvement of students in activity/event
  - 2 awards per College and 1 award for non-academic units
  - \$2000 in 4 areas: Global Course Development, Global Travel, Global Research, and Global Events



## **GLOBAL SCHOLAR PROGRAM**

### **Objective:**

 Create distinction and recognition among students for engagement in specialized instruction (global courses) and experiences (global events and travel)

#### Outcome:

Increase students' global competency (knowledge, skills, engagement)

#### **Global Scholar Status:**


- Awarded upon completion and documentation (in ePortfolio) of a wide range of global activities (courses, events/activities, optional: travel)
- All incoming freshman students required to:
  - Complete GCAA
  - Begin constructing ePortfolio
  - Complete at least 1 Global Course
