Committee Reports	Budget Committee: Senators Hendricks, Odom, and Seminet reported that the President's Budget Advisory Council recommended a merit raise for faculty, but we will have to wait to see what the A&M System decides with respect to tuition increases and merit raises. The Council also recommended scrapping course fees in favor of program fees. Departments will make requests for those fees directly to their respective deans.	
Unfinished Business	Questions remain about Coach Morris and the football team: Has the \$1200 been raised, and when will the stolen newspaper be reissued? Were the 3 students in fact disciplined? Why didn't the Coach appear before the Senate as requested? A motion was made to express dissatsifaction with the manner in which the University handled the newspaper affair.
