Communication from Senate President Crenshaw	<p>President Crenshaw reported discussion topics from his meeting with the President and Provost.</p> <p>Piper Award protocol has been issued and the call for nominees is forthcoming.</p> <p>Presidential search committee has not been appointed yet.</p> <p>Faculty parking concerns especially spaces at the science building were discussed. President McFarland will contact campus police and ask them to monitor blue parking areas more closely for violators. He asked faculty to keep individual logs and forward them to the appropriate committee chair.</p> <p>Dr. Crenshaw expressed his concern about the rigid method for processing curriculum changes.</p> <p>Dr. Crenshaw will meet with the President and Provost the day before each faculty senate meeting this year. He encouraged senators to send their concerns to him prior to that date each month.</p>
