Reports

Academic Practices: Senator Openshaw handed out responses to the Class Scheduling Survey. Over 100 surveys were returned. 45% of the respondents indicated a preference for a two day a week schedule. However, 65% of the respondents would like to see a different schedule for two days a week than the one proposed (M-R & T-F with no classes on Wednesdays).

This committee will survey faculty for interest in establishing a mid-October fall break for the university.

**Awards:** Senator vonDuvillard reported the call for nominations for Faculty awards has been sent. Those nominated will receive a letter outlining portfolio submission criteria. Portfolio materials will be limited this year and should be submitted online.
