Thank you for your letter, dated October 8, 2013, regarding revisions to the core curriculum offered at Texas A&M University-Commerce, effective fall 2014.

Revisions to the core curriculum reflect a comprehensive review of general education requirements, precipitated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) requirement that all state institutions review and revise institutional core curriculum.

A comparison of "old" and "new" core curriculum courses accompanied the letter of notification.
