Dear Dr. Wheelan:

As required by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) *Substantive Change for SACSCOC Accredited Institutions*, policy statement, we are writing to provide notification that Texas A&M University-Commerce has entered into a dual degree arrangement with a foreign institution not accredited by SACSCOC. An agreement with Jeju National University, Jeju City, South Korea, was signed by both institutions on July 10, 2015; a copy of the agreement has been provided with this letter.

SACSCOC policy for *Agreements Involving Joint and Dual Academic Awards*, describes a dual degree arrangement as:

An agreement by two or more institutions to grant dual academic awards is one whereby students study at two or more institutions and each institution grants a separate academic award bearing only its name, seal, and signature.

The terms of A&M-Commerce's agreement with Jeju National University were guided by this policy statement, with both institutions awarding separate academic awards to their students who have met the graduation requirements of their home institution. Additionally, A&M-Commerce will continue to comply with SACSCOC Principles 3.5.2, 3.5.4, and 3.7.1 of the *Principles of Accreditation*.

Please accept this letter as notification of our intent to implement the terms of the agreement with Jeju National University beginning immediately (August 29, 2016).
