Procedure Summary

The Graduate Council establishes basic course standards for completion of additional master's degree programs at Texas A&M University-Commerce.

This procedure documents the course requirements for additional master's degree programs.

Procedures and Responsibilities

- 1 Students holding a master's degree from a regionally accredited graduate institution in the United States may apply certain courses that were part of a previously earned graduate degree towards an additional master's degree from A&M-Commerce.
 - 2 Such courses must be approved by the Department Head/Director and the Graduate Dean.
 - 3 Courses from previous degrees cannot be more than six years old at the time the additional master's degree is conferred.
 - 4 No more than one-third of the coursework for the additional master's degree can be from a previously earned degree.
 - 5 Previous Research component courses, or their equivalent, must be approved by the department head and Graduate Dean before the course is applicable towards an additional master's degree. A minimum of two-thirds of the courses applied to satisfy the requirements for the additional master's degree must be A&M-Commerce courses.
 - 6 Additional master's degrees will be subject to the general regulations governing master's degrees as outlined in University Procedure *11.99.99.R0.09 Requirements for the Master's and Specialist Degree* except as stated above.
