The field practicum experience is the signature pedagogy for social work education. Criteria by which students demonstrate the achievement of program competencies lays the foundation for supervision, coordination and evaluation of student activities. Ten core competences consisting of 41 practice behaviors constitute the learning experience for students earning a BSW degree.

Students are not required complete activities for all practice behaviors *each semester*. Students may repeat tasks and activities linked with any of the practice behaviors across the semesters. However, it is expected students will demonstrate skills and abilities in each of these areas over the course of their field practicum.

The attached checklist is to serve as a guide for the student, field liaison and field instructor or task supervisor to ensue the student has engaged in tasks for all practice behaviors.
