## **Admission Requirements to Field Based Program**

To gain admission to the Field-Based Program, you will make application to the program while enrolled in ELED or SED 300, plus the following requirements must be met:

Overall GPA must be 2.75;

Have a minimum of 12 semester credit hours in the subject-specific content area for the certification sought. A minimum of 15 semester credit hours is required for certification sought in mathematics or science at or above Grade 7;

TSI Complete - demonstrate basic skills in reading, written communication, and mathematics;

Participate in either an interview or other screening instrument (YouTube video) to determine applicant's knowledge, experience, skills and aptitude are appropriate for the certification sought;

Accept offer of admission to the Field-Based Program by completing an Acceptance Survey.

The application screening process occurs throughout the semester in which the student is enrolled in ELED or SED 300.

\*SED 300 and RDG 350: Overall GPA of 2.50

TSI complete in Math, Reading and Writing Any course co- or pre-requisite

\*RDG 360 and RDG 370:

Score 250 or higher on the RDG THEA; or 23 Composite and 23 English on ACT; or 1070 Combined and 550 Critical Reading/Verbal on SAT Overall GPA of 2.75
TSI complete in Math and Writing
Any course co- or pre-requisite met

Full admission to the Field-Based Teacher Education Program is required prior to completing an internship as an educational aide. Students must submit an application to complete Internship as an educational aide in the Field-Based Teacher Education Program. The application process occurs during the spring / fall semester prior to beginning internship. Students should contact their academic advisor for questions concerning readiness to apply for student teaching.
