Enclosed is my application for the Adjunct Professor of Music Theory position at Texas A&M Commerce. I am currently pursuing a second PhD degree at the University of North Texas. Although I'm primarily a composer, my first PhD was very academic and research-focused. It has resulted in many publications on Music Theory, Analysis, and Composition that have acquired many citations. Given my most recent interest in Intermedia and Electronic Music, I decided to go to the University of North Texas for a more practice-based program with a minor in New Media.

My most relevant teaching experience includes courses in Music Theory, Composition, Instrumentation, and Electronic Music, besides coordinating a platform for the collaboration between filmmakers and composers at UNT and at The University of Texas at Tyler. At UT Tyler, I have been putting my effort into developing the interest in Electronic Music by teaching a course on the subject and promoting the first acousmatic concert at that institution. I have also been committed to fostering an active, creative environment for a small but increasingly engaged composition studio. Recently, I have planned collaborations with the school's ensembles, resulting in performances from the Jazz Ensemble, the Brass Quintet, and the Wind Ensemble. When teaching a Topics in Music Theory course, I have applied an innovative intertextual approach to music analysis and composition that favors a mathematical approach to music and allows for the teaching of computer-assisted Music Analysis and Composition. As a recruiting strategy, I led the Composer's Mentorship Program, where students from high schools in the region had the opportunity to interact with composition majors, have composition lessons with the faculty, and have their music played in a final recital. I have taught guitar and music theory in my private practice, both classical and popular, for fifteen years. Regardless of the subject, I always try to include works of underrepresented composers as examples since they often enrich and expand students' perspectives. I also have experience teaching in diverse backgrounds, from children in underserved communities in Rio de Janeiro to college-level in Brazil and the US.

My creative work covers various styles and methods, including Electronic and Generative Music, Intermedia, Computer-Assisted Composition, and more traditional instrumental music informed by my cultural background. My orchestral music has received prizes like the OPUS 1 composition contest and the UFRJ National Compositional Competition. As a performer, I have a bachelor's degree in orchestral conducting and have premiered several works, especially by Brazilian composers.
