

Summer Thesis/Dissertation Fellowship

The Graduate School has limited funds for a summer fellowships to be awarded to master's, specialist, and doctoral students who are completing a thesis or dissertation during the Summer 2021 or Fall 2021 semester. These fellowships are awarded on a competitive basis and are intended for students who plan to spend the majority of the summer working on their thesis or dissertation.

Fellowship Award

Each fellowship award will be \$1,000. If you are receiving financial aid during the term of the fellowship award, **there may be a need to adjust the total financial aid award**. Please contact the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships (903-886-5096) for additional information about how this fellowship may affect financial aid. Please note that fellowship funding is limited and only complete application packets will be reviewed for final award determination.

Eligibility- To be eligible for this fellowship, a student must:

- be a master's, specialist, or doctoral student in good academic standing at A&M-Commerce.
- have **received proposal approval** from the Graduate School/Thesis & Dissertation Services **no later than April 16, 2021**.
- be enrolled in at least three (3) hours of a thesis (518) course or dissertation (718) course during one of the summer terms for the fellowship period.

Application Process- Submit via email a complete application packet to Thesis & Dissertation Services that includes the documents listed below. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

- Application form; and
- Two-page (maximum) description with the following information:
 - An overall summary of the project in non-technical language;
 - A summary of what work has been completed to-date;
 - A summary of what work remains for the thesis or dissertation to be completed; and
 - A project timeline (table or bulleted list) with the projected dates for completion of your thesis or dissertation.
