General Information

- Transfer courses with a grade of “D” or better, will be acceptable as transfer credit unless otherwise noted by your major department.
- If a student takes the approved Core courses at HCCD, they are annotated on their transcript with a Core code and will be accepted as fulfilling that portion of the Core at A&M-Commerce.
- **A student who has completed the HCCD Core curriculum is Core complete at A&M-Commerce.**
- If a student attended a college requiring a total Core of less than 43 semester credit hours (SCH), 36-42 SCH, that student will need to complete the A&M-Commerce core curriculum hour requirements, including the 2 hour PE requirement, up to 43 semester credit hours.
- For degree completion, a MINIMUM of 60 SCH must be taken at A&M University-Commerce or another senior level institution. A MAXIMUM of 60-66 SCH from a junior/community college may be applied to a bachelor degree, depending upon specific degree requirements.
- For degree completion, at least 25 percent of credit semester hours must be earned through instruction at A&M-Commerce. Furthermore, at least 24 of the final 30 semester hours must be taken at Texas A&M University-Commerce. Extension and correspondence credits may be used to satisfy residence requirements.
