

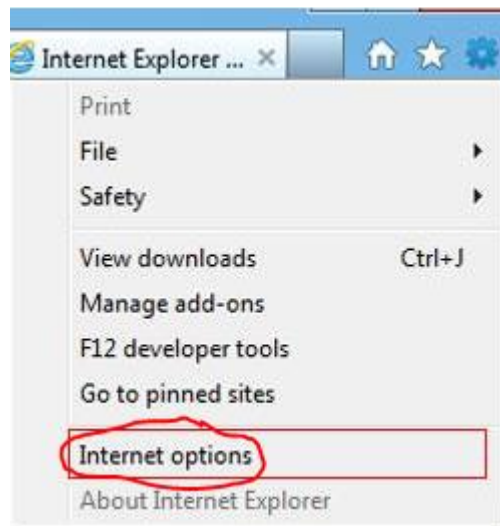
Accepting Cookies On Internet Explorer 10

At times one might run into difficulty accessing a page or desired location. One reason that such difficulties might occur may be due to the security settings on the computer in use. If the computer is not set to accept cookies, a page may be blocked. In order to accept cookies, and hopefully access the desired location, the following steps can be taken:

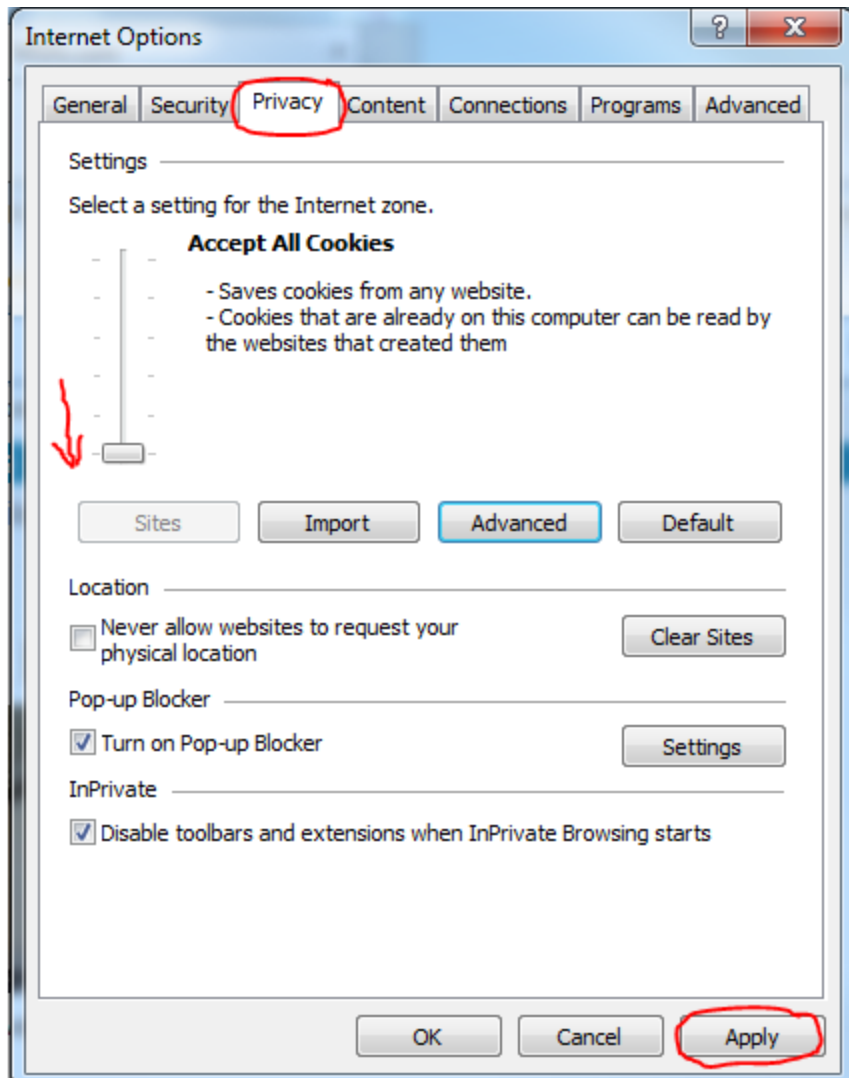
1. Start by clicking on the tools menu.



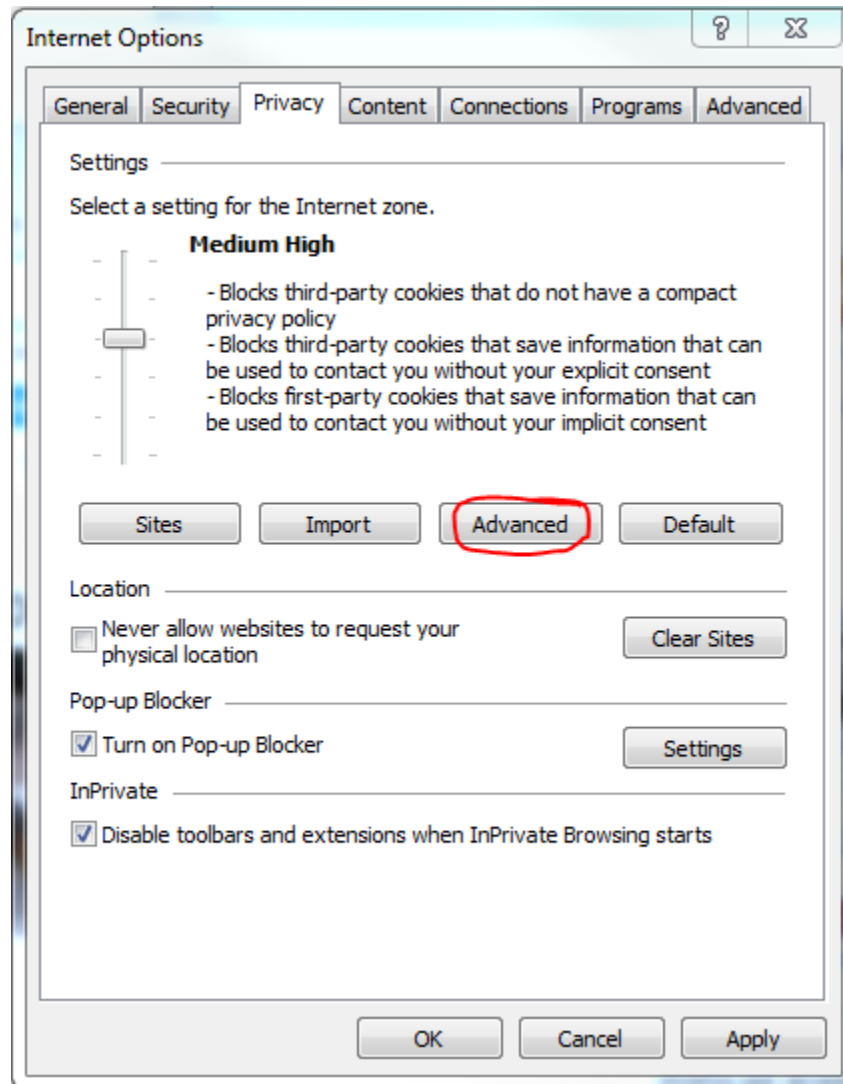
2. Select **Internet Options** from the dropdown list that appears.



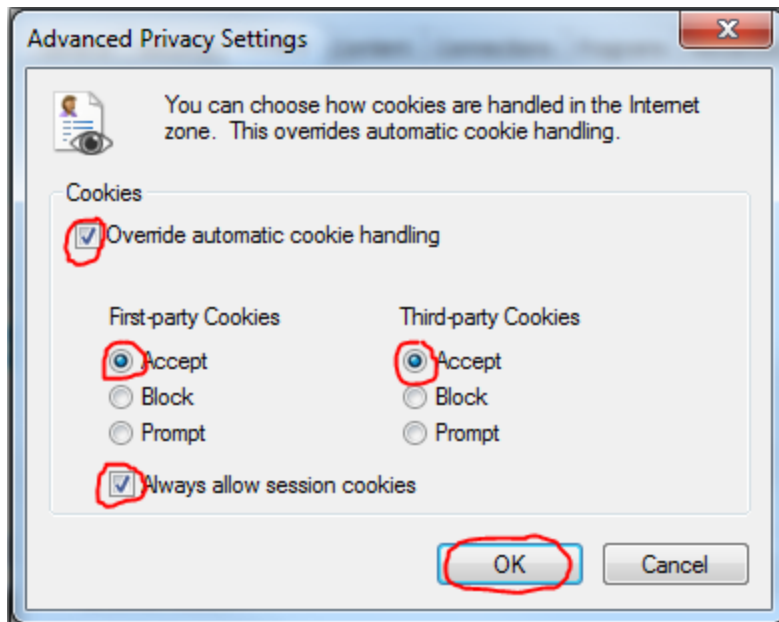
3. Next select **Privacy**. From here there are two main ways that you can change your settings for cookies.
 - a. The first option is to slide the bar that you see on the left-hand side all the way to the bottom. When the bar is all the way down, the bold writing will say **Accept All Cookies**. Once you see this, click **Apply**.



b. The second option is to select **Advanced**.



4. Next select **Override automatic cookie handling, Always allow session cookies**, and click **Accept** for **First-party Cookies** and **Third-party Cookies**. If you want to customize the settings with this option—you can. (i.e. Some may choose to accept first-party cookies and block third-party cookies. There is more freedom with this option.)



5. Exit by clicking the red X. Congratulations! You are all done!
