The U.S. Department of State (DOS) requires all new J-1 Exchange Visitors coming to a U.S. university to demonstrate sufficient English proficiency [22 CFR §62.10(a)(2)] before the university may issue the DS-2019 documentation for the scholar to enter the U.S. The DOS has established three general methods for determining English proficiency listed below.
