## **Qualifications for Candidates**

To qualify for the position of Student Senator or Executive Officer, you must be a regularly enrolled student at Texas A&M University-Commerce (an undergraduate must be registered for at least nine hours each long semester during his/her term of office, and a graduate student must be enrolled for at least six hours each long semester during his/her term of office). Each applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater at the time of application. Transfer students need a 2.5 or greater from their previous institution. Incoming Freshmen do not need a GPA to be a part of the organization, but need to achieve at least a 2.5 after their first semester as Senator. In addition, applicants must be in good standing at the time of submitting their application and must maintain that standing if they are elected into the Senate.

## **Senate Members are expected to:**

- Promptly and regularly attend Senate meetings held in a designated room in the Rayburn Student Center at 6 p.m. on Wednesdays. Virtual accommodations can be made.
- Act as a leader, organizer, and representative of the Student Government Association.
- Adhere to the rules and regulations of the SGA Governing Documents.
- Act as a liaison between the students, various campus organizations, administration, faculty, and staff.
- Attend all conferences and meetings that affect the interests of the student body.
- Fulfill two office hours per week throughout the course of their term.
  - o Executive Officers must complete ten office hours per week during their term.

The Student Senate is a serious organization designed to serve, represent, empower, meet the needs, and protect the rights of Texas A&M University-Commerce students. This responsibility should not be taken lightly. Prospective applicants must be willing to make a total commitment to the interests of students and the success of the Student Government Association.
